In order to integrate the cross cutting issues relevant to Gender , Environment and sustainability, human values and professional ethics ,the college has imbibed different types of topics/chapters in the curriculum. The institution takes care to focus on these issues. Some enhances professional competencies while others aim to inculcate general competencies like social values, human values, environment sensitivity to the holistic development of the students. Environmental studies is a compulsory subject for all under graduate second year students related to Environment and sustainability. Actually the University decides the syllabus and the college has to follow it. But in this limitation college also does its best for the above mentioned issues through NSS,YRC,RRC, Eco club, Value Added cell.

1. **Gender sensitivity:** Number of programmes are conducted for the students such as organization of International Women's day. National Girl child Day, Seminar on "women Empowerment" ,"Women in leadership" , Programme on "child rights & their protection", self defence training prramme. The YRC and NSS unit of the college have been very proactive in organizing various extension activities not only in college premises but also in adopted nearby villages. Programmes are also focussed on painting, elocution and essay on women empowerment and save girl child, female foeticide.

As per state government ,college has constituted Internal Complaint committee since 2016.

2. **Environment & Sustainability:** The active units of college YRC ,Eco club & NSS promotes environment protection through tree plantatation,

“Observance of World Environment Day”, “Banomahostav”, cleaning the campus under swachha Bharat Abhijan and Swachhata Pakhwar. Debate ,painting competition, seminars are also organized.

3. **Human values and professional Ethics:** To create scientific approach and social awareness among the students, lectures, Essay writings are conducted by the department of Odia, Political science, Psychology. National festivals like Independence day, Republic Day ,Rastiya Ekta Diwas, Gandhi Jayanti serve as a platform to enliven the patriotism and moral values among all. Observance of Road Safety Week, Vigilance Awareness week, World AIDS day, National Youth Day activate the social responsibility among students.
