#### **Objectives** of Alumni's feedback on institute:


Alumni's feedback has three main objectives:

2. To assess the success of academic provision in relation to the expectations of both the parents and the students.


3. To provide feedback to the faculties in order to improve delivery and/or content of the curriculum.



#### **TEACHINGS AND LEARNINGS:**


- Delivery of structured lectures and completion of syllabus in time

- A capable counsellor with regard to Academic, career planning and related matters.





## 4. REPORT OF TEACHERS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS


