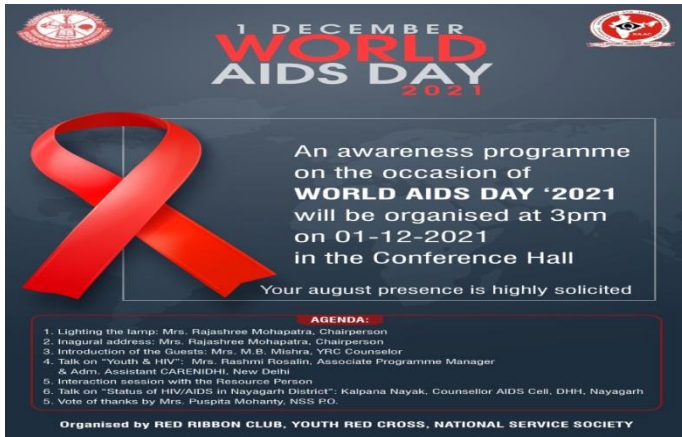

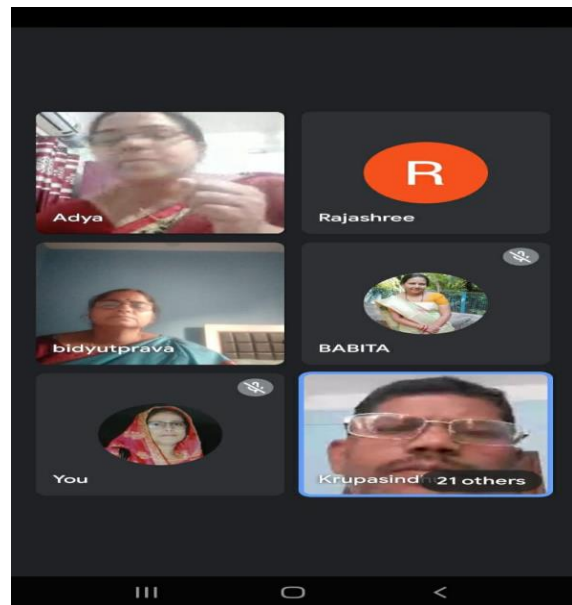
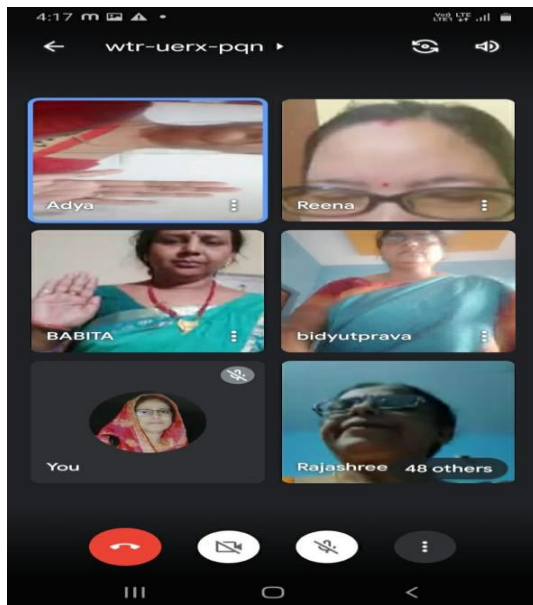


CONSTITUTION DAY 2020
