Final Year/Final Semester exams shall be held in online mode as decided earlier. For these students, commencement of physical classroom teaching has got no meaning.

2.

Physical classroom teaching will commence from 16th August for PG First Year and UG intermediate Year students (i.e. UG second year in case of 3-year UG course and UG second and third years in case of 4-year UG course).

3.

UG First year students shall not come for physical classroom teaching now. A decision about them shall be taken in September depending on the covid situation.

4.

All research scholars are permitted for physical presence in the campus.

5

Hostels shall be opened for all research scholars as well as for those students whose physical classroom teaching commences from 16th August.

6.

Universities and Autonomous Colleges to conduct exams for First Year and intermediate Year(s) students in whichever mode suitable to them and at whatever time suitable to them.

Sub: Commencement of Physical Classroom teaching in Universities and Colleges w.e.f. 16.08.2021 and conduct of examinations for UG & PG Courses

Madam/Sir,


In view of improvement in Covid-19 situation in the state, the following decisions have been taken.

1. State Public Universities and Government as well as Non-Government Degree Colleges (coming under H.E. Department) are hereby directed to commence physical classroom teaching for all PG and UG students, except 2020-21 UG First Year students, from **16<sup>th</sup> August 2021**. (Since Final Year/ Final Semester examinations have already started or going to start soon, there is no necessity for physical classroom teaching of 2020-21 PG and UG Final Year students. Their examinations shall be held in online mode as had been decided earlier vide H.E. Department Letter No. 25110 Dated 28.06.2021.)
2. State Public Universities and all Autonomous Colleges (Government as well as Non-Government) are hereby allowed to take appropriate decision at their level for conducting semester/annual examinations, in online/offline (pen & paper)/ blended (online/offline) mode, for students of all remaining Years/Semesters. The HEIs should prepare their own examination calendar so as to ensure on-time graduation of these students in the coming years.
3. Teaching and research activities of Ph.D., M.Phil. and other research scholars shall also commence in physical mode w.e.f. 16.08.2021, if not commenced already.



4. Hostels shall be opened from 14.08.2021 only for the students whose classroom teaching will start in physical mode from 16.08.2021 and also for Ph.D., M.Phil. and other Research Scholars. All possible Covid-19 prevention protocols shall be followed in hostels.
5. Following Covid-19 Prevention Protocols shall be followed in all HEIs.
- Teachers/ Staff/ Students residing in Containment Zones shall not come to University/ College.
  - Face Mask/ Face Cover shall be mandatory.
  - Frequent Hand Wash/ Hand Sanitization shall be ensured.
  - Social Distancing shall be adopted in classrooms, libraries, laboratories, etc. If need be, crowded classes can be divided into batches and teaching hours in a day can be extended.
  - Spitting in campus shall be strictly prohibited.
  - Respiratory etiquettes shall be strictly followed. (i.e. Covering one's mouth and nose by handkerchief while coughing/ sneezing)
  - Self-monitoring of health and reporting of illness should be encouraged.
  - There must be an isolation room ready for any emergency.
  - Whenever possible, the physical classroom teaching shall be recorded and shared with absentee students.
6. State Private Universities (under H.E. Department) may also consider following these guidelines to the extent required by them.




